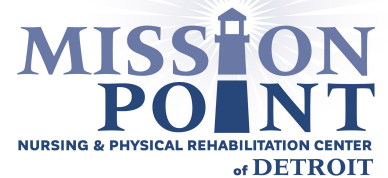

WOMEN EYE HEALTH & SAFTY MONTH

Fewer than 1 in 10 U.S. Women know that women are at greater risk of permanent vision loss than men according to a new national survey.

A new survey has revealed that only nine percent of American women realize that women are at a greater risk of suffering permanent vision loss than men.

Prevent Blindness Florida and Prevent Blindness, a national non-profit organization, sponsored the survey to gain insight into the public's perceptions about women's eye and vision health.

Women Eye Health Stats:

- 65% of women have age related-macular degeneration
- 61% of women have glaucoma
- 61% of women have cataracts

- 56% of women have refractive error
- 63% of women have vision impairment
- 66% of women are blind
